Bus Lay-by

Please DO NOT park or turn your vehicle in the bus lay-by or along the front of the school. This area must be kept free of all traffic to ensure our children's safety. The pedestrian gate is open to facilitate children walking to and from school and is not for children getting dropped off or picked up by car. Please respect these rules. The lower church carpark should be used for parents/guardians to drop children off and pick children up.

Dropping Off and Picking Up

Thank you for following the one-way system on entering and exiting the church carpark. Please DO NOT STOP or wait in the YELLOW BOX at the top of the carpark. This is a major safety risk, and it inhibits staff, support agencies and other families arriving on time. Please park in a space to drop your child to school and remind your children they should not climb on or over the walls at the Parochial House. Your children's safety is our priority!
